Visit to the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge – Hong Kong Boundary Crossing Facilities

The Hong Kong – Zhuhai – Macao Bridge (HZMB) is a mega-size sea crossing linking the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR), Zhuhai City of Guangdong Province and Macao Special Administrative Region. The Hong Kong Boundary Crossing Facilities (HKBCF) is located on an artificial island of about 130 hectares reclaimed from the open waters off the northeast of the Hong Kong International Airport. A non-dredge reclamation for reclaiming the part of the artificial island for HKBCF which reduce the amount of dredging and dumping of marine mud.

HKIEIA is organising a visit to HZMB - HKBCF in February. The visit will include a briefing of the HZMB project and the non-dredged reclamation method, a visit to the HZMB Project Information Centre and a boat trip.
