Hong Kong 2030: Planning Vision and Strategy, Stage 3 Public Consultation

Further to the extensive research and public consultations that were released to the public in November 2001 and November 2002 for the HK2030 Study. A briefing to HKIEIA, Department of Biology and Chemistry of City University and CIWEM was organized on 16 March 2004, forming a part of Stage 3 public consultation for the HK2030 Study.

Mr. Alfred Lau, Chief Town Planner of Planning Department has introduced the key assumptions for the future development of Hong Kong adopted in the Study. He has also presented the options that would meet future development requirements and their implication. Participants from a wide range of background and expertise had shared their views on how vision and goal could be in line with the received community views in the Study regarding i) provision of quality living environment ii) enhancement of economic competitiveness iii) strengthening the links with the Mainland.

Members took great interest in this stage of the Study and the briefing was followed by a Q&A session with a lively exchange of views and it has provided an excellent forum for participants to freely express their views.
